As part of national economic recovery efforts in 2009, the City of Whitefish received a \$3.5 million Transportation Infrastructure Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) grant from the US Department of Transportation for the Highway 93/2nd Street Improvement Project. Design is complete and construction is set to begin on September 12, 2011.

Project Status

Team Transition

Due to TIGER guidelines, the engineers overseeing construction are not the design engineers. The construction oversight team at Stelling Engineers has worked closely with the City and the designers at WGM Group for several months to ensure the transition is as seamless as possible. Please contact Stelling Engineers with any future questions.

Contract Awarded

The City has awarded the construction contract to the firm, LHC Inc. LHC will be responsible for reconstruction of two blocks of Highway 93, from Spokane Avenue to Baker Avenue, including those intersections. Construction will also include sewer improvements to Lupfer Avenue.

Traffic & Parking Restriction

Construction will require extensive detours with substantial impacts to downtown traffic. The detour routes will change throughout the job. Information on the initial detour routes is available inside this newsletter and from the City Public Works Department. A current detour route map will always be posted on the project website. Due to the need to detour highway traffic onto City streets, there will be parking restrictions on detour routes. The first phase of construction on the Highway 93/2nd Street project is scheduled to begin September 12th and is expected to end in November. After a winter shutdown the project will start up again in spring of 2012.

Business and property owners along 2nd Street (between Baker and Spokane Avenues) and others who are interested in learning more about upcoming construction activities are encouraged to attend.

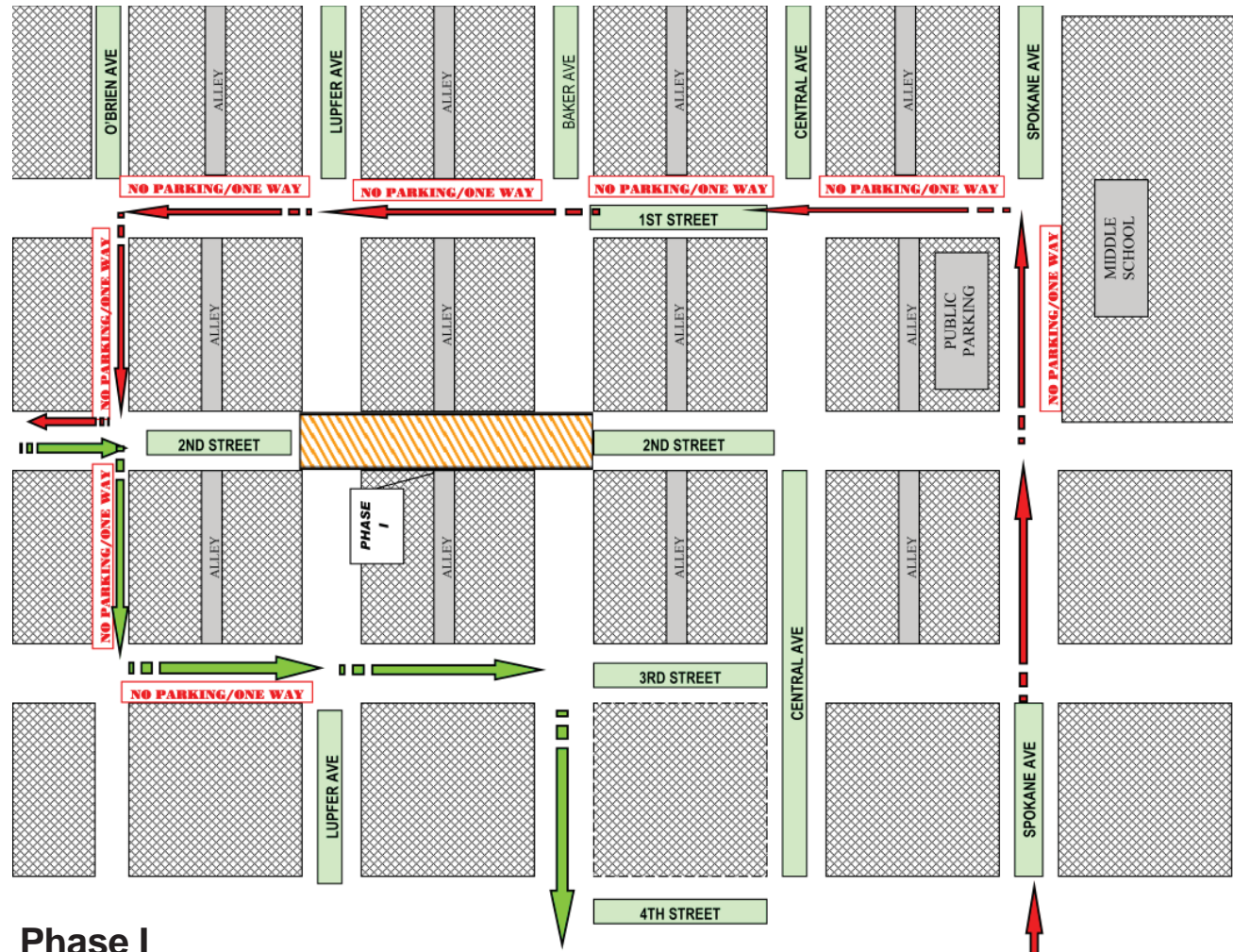

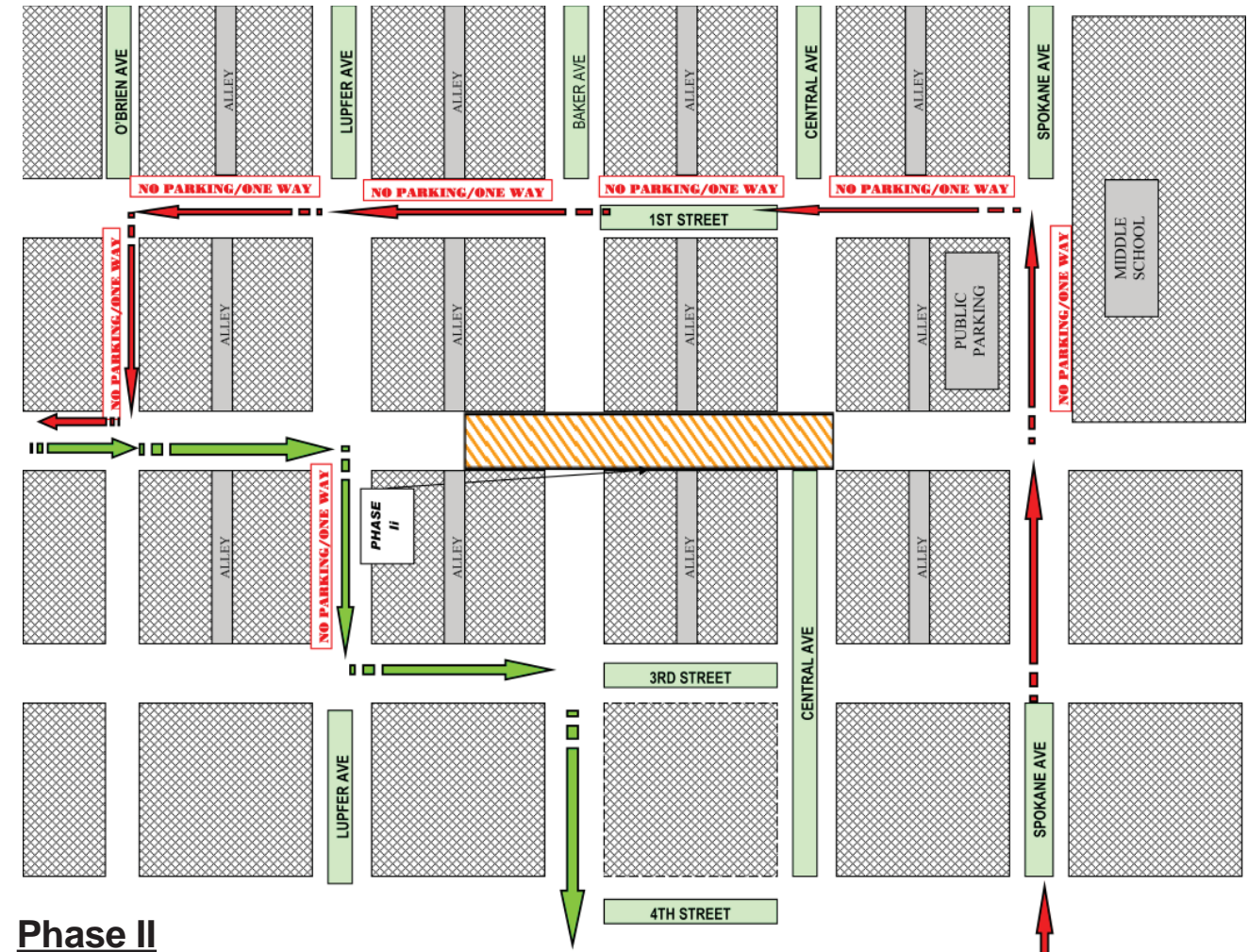
